Home Repair Assistance Application FOR HOMEOWNERS ONLY

The Group Workcamp is an intensive one-week trip that helps people grow in Christian faith through service. Youth and adults from around the US will spend one week in our communities performing hands-on home repair projects for homeowners who are elderly, disabled, and/or of modest income.

Four to five young people and at least one adult leader will complete the work at each house. The project will be supported, as well, by local communities, businesses and other helping organizations. Site writers will visit your home prior to the Workcamp and help with identifying repairs and materials needed for your specific project. Eligible Minnesota households must be in either Clay or Wilkin Counties. Eligible repairs are light in nature and are listed within the application.

Both labor and materials will be free to qualifying households. Households receiving assistance must agree to provide water, electricity for tools, and a restroom for the workers, as well as providing an adult in the home the week of the repairs.
